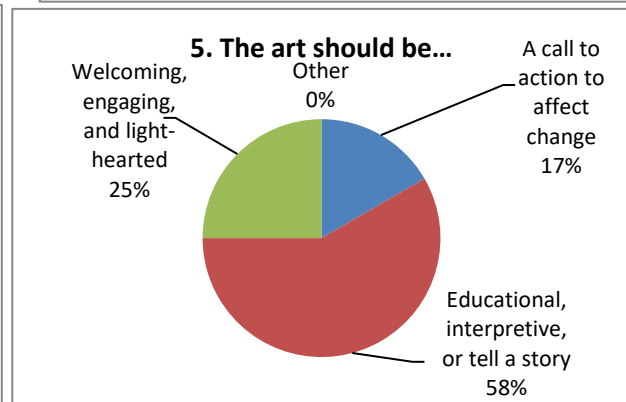
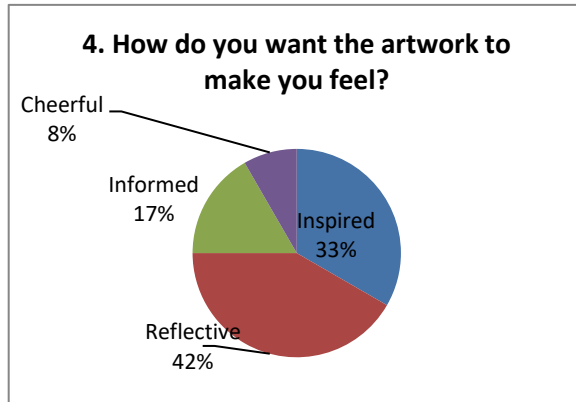
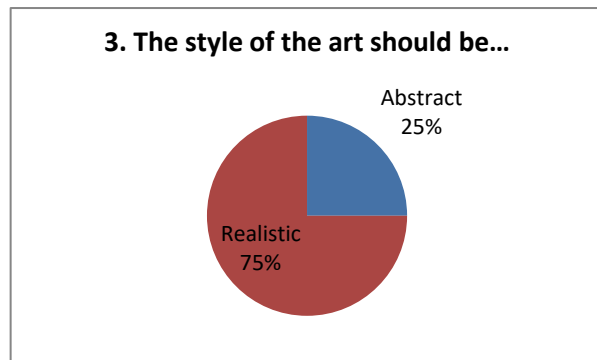
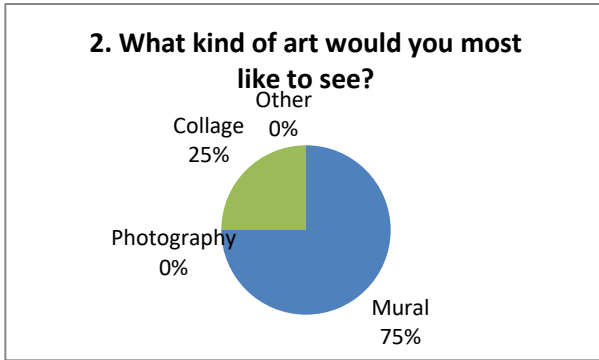
**Total responses:** 35

**Email & Virtual feedback:** Public recommendations included combining themes presented in the project survey, mostly that of the role of the Black family in civil rights history combined with notable Eastside and African American persons who have been instrumental in Eastside life and culture. Other feedback included highlighting the inspirational story of Mrs. ZerNona Black and music that is consistent with the period of notable Eastside members. Encouragement was provided to work with cultural institutions such as San Antonio African American Community Archive & Museum (SAAACAM) and involving East side schools and students.

**Summary of Findings:** Results indicate a realistic mural that is educational, interpretive, and tells a story is preferred. Thematically, the community is interested in the history of San Antonio's Eastside and life and legacy of ZerNona Black.
